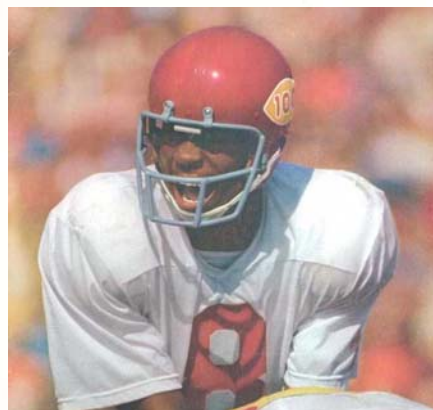


TelPAC Breakfast Speaker
JAMES JONES
Former Quarterback for USC

James Jones was born in Wilmington, Delaware June 23rd 1950. He moved to Harrisburg, Pa. with his family when he was in the 1st grade. James is a product of the Harrisburg School District. He was an All-American quarterback and graduated with honors from John Harris High School in 1968. James attended the University of Southern California where he had an illustrious football career. During his tenure he led the team to a Rose Bowl victory in 1970, became the all-time offensive leader in school history, and was a Heisman Trophy candidate during the 1971 football season. After not being drafted by the NFL he sat out a year before getting a free agent offer to play in the Canadian Football League in 1973. James established himself as one of the top quarterbacks in the league leading his team to two Grey Cup appearances (equivalent to the Super Bowl). He was an all conference selection in 1974-75, and an all-pro selection in 1975. James ended his career in 1980 and returned to Harrisburg to embark on life after football.

James entered the ministry during 1980 and received his ordination in 1983. He has spent the past twenty five years developing his ministry and serving Central Pa. and the immediate Harrisburg community. He has earned the reputation of having a special gift in working with young people and has focused his ministry on youth. James has counseled in several schools and a variety of youth agencies throughout the Harrisburg area.

James married his high school sweet heart Amy and they have two sons; Jamal 30 and Ahmad 23.

James is currently employed with the Susquehanna Township School District and has a professional relationship with the Boys and Girls Club of Central Pa.
